North Park University is a fully accredited four-year Christian liberal arts university with more than thirty liberal arts and pre-professional majors. <b>The North Park Dialogue (12sh)</b>	The North Park Dialogue is a three-course sequence in which students encounter life's great questions in the context of their academic lives. The course, which meets in large-group and discussion sessions led by full-time faculty members, is an interdisciplinary humanities course which emphasizes reading, reflection and writing. For transfer students, placement in the Dialogue courses is based upon total accepted transfer credit.

**English Composition and Philosophy Requirements:** Within North Park Dialogue Courses I and II, there is a strong writing and philosophy component. If your credit amount places you in Dialogue III but you have not had a previous composition or philosophy class, you may be required to take these courses at North Park.
