

CHURCH MATCHING GRANT APPLICATION FORM

Application deadline: August 1

Churches are invited to participate in our Church Matching Grant program for traditional undergraduate students (formerly PIE). North Park University will match a church grants or scholarships given to North Park in the name of a traditional undergraduate student up to \$500 per academic year for the duration of undergraduate studies at North Park. Note, the church gift and matching North Park grant are applied evenly between both the fall and the spring semester.

Eligibility: Students must be full time (registered for at least 12 hours per semester) traditional undergraduate students.

Church Guidelines: Funds for the church scholarship must come from one of the following: (a) the annual church budget, (b) endowed sources, or (c) a special scholarship fund. If a special fund is created, contributions are given to the fund and not to individual students. Students and/or students' parents cannot contribute to the special fund (and thus benefit from their personal giving). The church affirms that the student is a participant in the life of the church.

We also encourage students to express their gratitude directly to their home church for such gifts and expressions of support.
