World Impact Oakland has an immediate opening for a Youth Director.

World Impact is a Christian missions organization committed to facilitating church-planting movements by evangelizing, equipping, and empowering the unchurched urban poor. Founded in 1971, World Impact is now in its 40<sup>th</sup> year and operates in 10 cities and four camps around the United States.

As World Impact is a Religious Missionary Order (RMO), all of our ministers consider themselves missionaries and commit to living incarnationally in the inner city, raising support, and living a simple lifestyle in serving Christ.

World Impact Oakland is based in west Oakland, CA in the neighborhood of “Lower Bottoms”. The ethnic makeup of the neighborhood is primarily Hispanic and African American. This neighborhood is filled with children who need a strong youth mentor.

We are searching to fulfill a Youth Director position whose responsibilities would consist of the following duties:

- Coordinating and leading a team of local volunteers to help with a youth program.
- Coordinate and lead youth events. This would include weekly group meetings with neighborhood youth (all ages), social outings, field trips, camping trips, etc..
- Prepare and Lead Bible Studies. As an organization deeply rooted in the calling to make disciples, the Youth Director needs to be adept at explaining biblical stories and concepts.
- Meet one on one with students. As important as it is to have large group meetings, it is even more important to care for individual students.
- Willing to lead as Youth Director for at least three years. These kids need stability in their mentors. Look at this last requirement as committing to job security!

Because we are an RMO in a low income inner city neighborhood, we are required to obtain our funds from outside sources. Depending on your financial situation we anticipate being able to fund the position through grants for the first two years. Fundraising may become part of this job description in the future.

- 2) Excellent communication skills
- 3) Self Motivated and good at organizational skills
- 4) Love of Christ and Children
