Community Covenant Church is celebrating its 25 anniversary. It is a relatively young congregation that is seeking to be re-envisioned as to what God has in store. This past year we committed to journeying the "path of congregational vitality" as set by our denomination, The Evangelical Covenant Church. As a part of that conversation was to move ahead in the area of youth ministry, in particular, to secure an intern for an academic year.

Our church is situated in a farming community. Huntley MN has a population of about 100. Our church draws from the surrounding communities such as Fairmont, Blue Earth, and Winnebago. We have a solid core of upper classmen in our youth group as well as a core of middle school students. We average on a given week 15-20 teens for our Wednesday Nite Youth group. We are looking for a person who would give shape and reshape our youth work as well as to give a greater ministry experience working with a growing church.

There are laity who are leading the youth ministry at this time. I would be acting as supervisor for the ministry. My undergraduate work was in youth ministry and have serve as youth pastor in the Duluth, MN area. I have also served as a youth coach for churches of the Northwest Conference of the Evangelical Covenant Church.

The youth director intern will

- Give evidence of a vital relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Demonstrate an outgoing personality and show a love for youth.
- Know the needs of young people and seek to address those needs.
- Exhibit good communication skills to both teens and adults.

The responsibilities of the youth director intern will

- Plan and carry out activities for Jr High and Sr High.
- Develop relationships with youth, parents and volunteer staff
- Reach out to youth who do not yet know Jesus
- Be a liaison between youth ministry and worship
- Plan and carry out one mission/service project
- Connect with parents and be a resource person to them
- Bring new ideas to youth ministry and seek to build an effective youth ministry.
- Shall be a resource person for the CE Commission
- Co-teach Confirmation
- Actively participate in the life of Community Covenant Church.
- Maintain personal, spiritual, and professional growth.

The youth director intern will

- Be accountable through weekly supervisory meeting with pastor and monthly meeting with CE Commission
- Work 20-30 hours per week for 10 month internship
- Negotiate vacation & time off
