I. General Description:

The Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministries (DYAM) supports the Roscoe United Methodist Church mission to connect youth (6th through 12th grade) and young adults (age 18 through 25 years) to Christ. The purpose of this ministry is to bring youth and young adults into an ever deepening relationship with Christ through study, fellowship, witness, prayer and service. All programs under the direction of the DYAM should be based on the following six key concepts: team approach, outreach, engaging, discipleship, community, and service.

Ministry with youth and young adults is broad and diverse, requiring an ever-expanding and committed core of volunteers. The DYAM is responsible for enlisting, training, nurturing and coordinating the work of these volunteers.

- b. Leadership will be by example and the programming will show the importance of a lifelong relationship with Christ and the Church.
