

UMIN ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

North Park Theological Seminary in cooperation with University Ministries is pleased to announce the **University Ministries Alumni Scholarship**. Each University Ministries Scholarship will offer \$5,000 (to be distributed \$2,500 per semester) toward tuition only at the seminary for one year. All prospective students are encouraged to apply. Candidates will be selected based on some or all of the following criteria:

- Acceptance into a degree program at North park Theological Seminary for full time study. Transfer students may apply; orientation students may not apply.
- Reference form to be completed by a UMIN staff member
- At least 2 years participation in a University Ministries program(s).

AWARDS:

The University Ministries Scholarship does not cover field education charges, fees, rent or other costs. After the first year, the students may be eligible for other scholarships and financial aid.

PROCESS:

Applicants must fill out a Financial Application for Federal Student Aid and in-house financial aid forms. An award on the standard financial aid system will be made immediately. If you receive a scholarship then this will replace the original award. Priority consideration date will be April 30 for students starting in the fall term. Please answer the following questions, and attach your answers on a separate sheet:

A. Describe your leadership & involvement at UMIN; include the programs and positions in which you served as well as the years and hours per week.

B. How did your experience with UMIN shape your decision to attend seminary and what future plans for ministry do you have?
