

PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

AT NORTH PARK THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

The Presidential Scholarship is given to students each year in cooperation with the Office of the President of the Evangelical Covenant Church.

Criteria to Qualify:

- 3.0 GPA.
- Acceptance into a MDIV or MACF degree program at North Park Theological Seminary
- Full-time on-campus study. (Transfer students may apply; orientation students may not apply.)
- Membership for at least one year at a Covenant church.
- Intention/openness to serve in the Evangelical Covenant Church.

Stipulations:

- Will serve in the Evangelical Covenant Church for three years upon graduation.
- Must complete the program in standard time as full-time residential students, in the three to four-year period as outlined in the catalog.
- Recipients will serve 40 hours of service per semester at selected North Park and denominational offices.
- Will work no more than 15 hours per week outside of classes.
- Students receiving a Presidential Scholarship will receive no other aid from North Park.

Awards:

The Presidential Scholarship covers full academic tuition only; it does not cover field education charges, fees, rent, and other costs. Notification letters will be mailed no later than May 10.

Process:

- Fill out the Financial Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and in-house financial aid form.
- Must have all degree and scholarship application materials in by the April 15 and October 1 \deadline.
- Priority consideration date is April 15 for fall, and October 1 for spring admission.
- Submit two essays (A and B) and complete the information below:
 - A. Please describe any previous ministry experiences you have had. Include dates, locations, and church/ministry names. Give a name and contact information for your supervisor. Indicate whether or not this was an Evangelical Covenant Church ministry and the approximate number of hours per week of your commitment. Use no more than 100 words per ministry experience.
 - B. What are your plans for ministry after graduation? Do you intend to serve in the Evangelical Covenant Church after graduation? Use no more than 100 words to answer part 'B.'
