**Elective Courses:**

- Students must choose additional courses above SPAN 2020 as elective to bring the total semester hours for the major to 36.
- Students who do not participate in a Spanish language foreign study must take at least 4sh of SPAN 4970: Internship in Community Spanish. This requirement may be waived for heritage speakers.
- SPAN course above SPAN 2020
- SPAN 4970: Internship in Community Spanish (2-4)
- All Spanish majors must complete a reflective portfolio of their work above the 1020 level.
- In addition to major requirements, secondary education students must take SPAN 3150 or its equivalent; 2040; and either 3160 or 3170; and must pass the Oral Proficiency Interview at the high intermediate level.
- Students interested in studying in Morelia, Mexico are required to complete SPAN 2130: Mexican History and Culture (4sh) prior studying abroad. SPAN 2130 is offered every fall semester.
- SPAN 2130 does not count towards the major.
