A Proven Method for Training the Next Generation of **Nonprofit Leaders**: A report conducted by LinkedIn in 2014 indicates a strong correlation between earning the Nonprofit Leadership Alliance's Certified Nonprofit Professional (CNP) credential and reaching a high level of leadership within the nonprofit sector.

50%

CNPs remain in the nonprofit sector 50% longer than non-CNPs.

CNPs are 7x more likely to reach a director level or higher position at a nonprofit organization than non-CNPs.
